The Red Parts: A Memoir by Maggie Nelson is the story of the killing of Jane Mixer – Ms. Nelson’s aunt – and its impact on her family. The crime was originally considered one of the famous “Michigan Murders” that occurred in Ann Arbor in the 1960s, but in 2005 (as the author was publishing a collection of poetry reflecting on the family tragedy) DNA evidence surfaced that implicated a new suspect.
