No person or public body shall fail to invite a portion of its members to a meeting for the purpose of circumventing the provisions of this act. N.J.S.A. 10:4-12. Meetings open to public; exceptions. a. Except as provided by subsection b. of this section all meetings of public bodies shall be open to the public at all times.

IDEA is the main law governing the education of students eligible for special education and related services. IDEA has eight main principles—most notably that students who qualify for special education services are to receive a free and appropriate public education (FAPE).

The Fairness Act is the second law in as many years liberalizing the use of funds on behalf of people with disabilities. Last Year, Congress enacted the ABLE law that allows persons with disabilities to have accounts that are sheltered from being counted as a resource for public benefits.
